International volleyball tournament "Auroras CUP 2022" regulations

I. General questions

- 1. This regulations determines the procedures, which take place in International tournaments "Auroras CUP 2022" (hereafter competition).
 - 2. Competition is held with purpose to popularize volleyball among young people.
- 3. Competition task is to gain the experience of international games for teams of sport schools and clubs.
 - 4. The organizer of the competition is Riga Volleyball School (hereafter organizer).

II. Competition place and time

- 5. Competition will take place of 4 November 6 November 2022.
- 6. Competition will take place in Riga Country German gymnasium sports hall, Āgenskalna Street 21 and will start on 4 of November 17:00.
- 7. Information about the competition will be published in internet website www.rigasvolejbolaskola.lv and Riga Volleyball School Facebook and Instagram.

III. Competition rules, participants and terms

- 8. In competition can participate 2007-year born and younger boys and girls.
- 9. In competition participates 6 boy and 6 girl teams from Europe. Composition of delegation: 12 players and 2 officials.

- 10. Competition will happen in accordance of International Volleyball federation (FIVB) competition rules.
 - 10.1 Teams play round robin tournament.
- 10.2 Game is played till 2 set win. Set is played till 25 points with two point difference, third set is played till 15 points with 2 point difference.

IV. Team applications for Competition

- 12. Team applications must be submitted to e-mail: abusa8@edu.riga.lv till 24th of October.
- 13. Original of team application must be submitted on first day of competition.
- 14. Foreign competition participants during time of competition must have health insurance.
 - 15. Organizer provides physical person data protection law requirements.
 - 16. The organizers of the competition cover the costs of lunch and dinner.
 - 17. The Competition participant or his represented organization pays travel expenses and accommodation costs.

V. Competition winners awards

- 18. The teams that took 1.-3. places and one best player in each team are awarded.
- 19. Competition teams are awarded with:
- 19.1.1.-3. teams with cups, medals, diploma and prizes;
- 19.2. Teams best players with prizes;
- 19.3. Teams participants with souvenirs.
